Definition

light pollution is the introduction by humans, directly or indirectly, of artificial light into the environment.





Energy consumption

> 30% of Light is spilled to the sky!

- Sint-Niklaas signed local Kyoto protocol.
 - -> 6% energy reduction realized by some small changes on public lighting system in a couple of months.

• Governments need to give the good example

Night Sky

- Science can not be done in serious way.
- Promoting astronomy is difficult
- Astronomers are the canary in the light polluted mines.

Night Sky

- Part of our natural environment
- Part of the natural landscape
- Part of our heritage! Worth to protect.
- Universal Declaration of Human Rights of Future Generations:

persons belonging to future generations have the right to an uncontaminated and undamaged Earth, with untainted skies, and are entitled to enjoy these as the basis of human history of culture and social bonds making each generation and individual a member of one human family

Techniques available to solve problem

- Light only there where needed
 - Is that facility needed to be lighten?
 - Is only the facility aimed to be lighten, lighted?
- Light only when needed
- Not more light then the amount needed
- The right color of light.



- Membership of General meeting
 - Formers
 - IDA BOD
 - Chapters and Affiliates 1 person / 10 IDA members





By-laws proposal

• Authorities of General meeting

- Changing of the by-laws.
- Nominating and deposing of the members of the board of directors.
- Nominating and deposing of the commissioners and auditor and defining their salary.
- The discharge of the board of directors and commissioners.
- The approval of the budget and financial report.
- The dissolution of the association.
- The exclusion of a member.
- The conversion of the association in a company with a social eye mark.
- The approval of the functioning report of the past period and the annual programmed of the current period established by the Board of Directors.
- Defining of the Internal Code with exception of the period between foundation of the association and the first general meeting.
- The approval of work and results of committees or study groups.



- Norms for road lighting in Europe
 - 1: road classes and lighting classes
 - 2: performance requirements
 - 3: performance calculations
 - 4: methods measuring lighting performance
- Is now under evaluation
- Countries asking things to change.



• Increase the TI to the old values


- Now: 10% and 15%

- Before: 15% and 20%

- Will cause much more glare.

- Poles can be places at higher distances (> 5 x height)

Think this result in lower energy cost.






• Lower lighting class allowed when using white light.

 - The road types like defined in EN-13201 need to be defined with the number of traffic per hour place of per day. This to create the possibility to have other lighting requirements based on the traffic intensity of that time.




